

Scholarships for Sderot's Summer Camps



Dear friend,

The 2014 summer vacation is approaching fast and we are busy planning this year's activities. We are proud that 2014 will be our eighth year of successful operation!

As always, we would like to financially assist any Sderot family who would otherwise be unable to send their child to camp. For many children, scholarships are the only way that they can be SAFE, with friends, and occupied during the long school vacation.

About 500 children and teens are expected to participate in our summer camps this year, among whom are approximately 180 children who are unable to afford camp tuition.

A \$160 DONATION WILL GUARANTEE THAT ONE OF THOSE 180 WILL ATTEND CAMP THIS SUMMER.

So far we have collected \$8,300 for scholarships, out of a total \$28,000 needed.

We work with various disadvantaged populations, including at-risk children and teens, young women in crisis, and Sderot's socially and economically needy families.
